### **Haringey Awareness Seminars / Autism Launch:**



GUBA Foundation hosted a free event for over 200 Ghanaian families. We arranged for autism experts to give advice on education and schooling, behavioural issues, respite care and autism facilities. Parents were given a rare opportunity to ask questions, network with service providers and other families like themselves. They heard from a father, a mother and a sister of people living with autism and their testimonies created an atmosphere of openness, helping to raise awareness and reduce the stigma within the community.

### **Training workshops:**



GUBA Foundation partnered with a speech therapist to bring much needed knowledge and training to parents/carers of children with autism. The free workshop gave the parents intimate access to an autism expert to help their child's communication and speech development at home. Resources were also made available post event.

### **Help a UK Based Family:**

As a foundation we also aim to support families living with autism. We are currently aiding a single father and his three autistic children. The family were in dire need with no housing, job and clothes for the children or money. GUBA Foundation connected the family to 2 organisations that helped them secure housing and offered support with the children. We also collected funds and provided the family with much needed goods such as clothes, jackets, shoes, nappies, food and bedding. We continue to aid this family and are currently trying to secure a solicitor to aid them with their on-going struggles.

## South London Awareness Seminar:



GUBA Foundation took the awareness campaign to the south of London. This time providing experts in speech therapy, parent training, accessing finance, social work and autism in women. 150 families benefited, gaining expert advice and knowledge in how to help their children.

## Help a Ghana Based Family:



We have partnered with the AACT School in Accra. We have raised funds and are currently supporting 2 families by paying the fees for the 2 children (pictured above) to attend the autism school.
